COURSE NAME:

Yellow Card Trained Operator Course.

COURSE COST:

\$350.00 per applicant for (two) categories SL and BL includes the use of the EWP and training and assessment material.

AGE REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must be over 18 years of age. Applicants under 18 will not be issued with a licence until they turn 18 years of age, but can work under supervision.

DURATION:

4-8 hours dependant on applicant's aptitude, prior experience and class size.

PREREQUISITES:

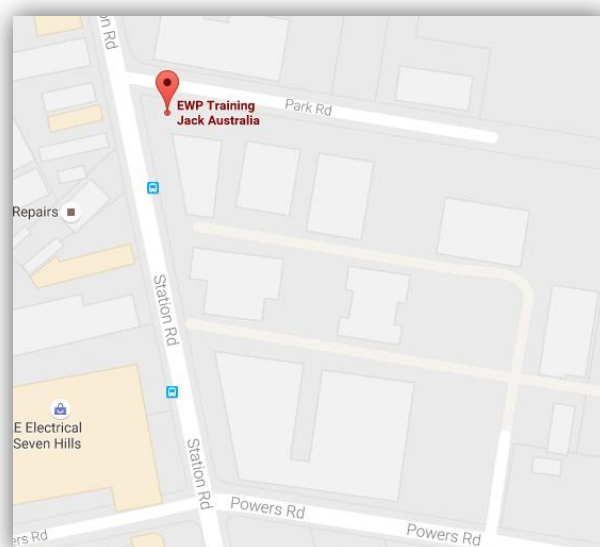

1. COURSE INTRODUCTION.

The Yellow Card course is recognised right around Australia as an EWP training course developed by the Elevating Work Platform Association, aimed at teaching people how to safely use elevating work platform equipment as part of their jobs.

This course is only for equipment lower than 11 metres.
The machinery categories are:

Scissor Lift (SL)
Self Propelled Boom Lift (BL)
Vertical Lift (VL)
Trailer Mounted Boom Lift (TL)
Truck Mounted Boom Lift (TM)

There may be anywhere between one and five people participating in the course at any given time. The material covered won't change according to the group size and it will run for 4-8 hours. However, participants may elect to sit for various courses, depending on the specific equipment they need to use. The course code is RIIHAN301D and this supersedes RIIHAN301B. At the end of the course, each participant receives a Yellow Card licence issued by the EWPA as an official certification. Nobody can legally operate equipment of this nature without it.

2. THE EWPA YELLOW CARD DOESN'T COVER THE OPERATION OF EQUIPMENT OVER 11 METRES.

Elevating work platform over 11 metre high risk WorkCover licence requires successfully completing an additional course (TLILIC2005A), which supersedes Elevating Work Platform Association Yellow Card Training Course the older course code TLILIC508A.

3. EWPA YELLOW CARD TRAINED OPERATOR TRAINING COURSE.

You are required to hold an EWPA Yellow Card trained operator licence if you are fulfilling certain roles in industries including: mining, maintenance, civil construction, extractive industries and general trade work that require the use of an elevating work platform. Employers in these industries should be acutely aware of the need for these qualifications before hiring staff for such roles.

4. COURSE OUTLINE.

All participants will gain practical and theoretical knowledge/skills in the following:

- Duty of care and relevant OH&S rules.
- Identification of hazards and assessment of risks and controls.
- Fitting and using the fall arrest harness and how to inspect it.
- Identification of safe operating boundaries by using manual and data plate information.
- Proper procedures for the set-up, use and shut down of all EWP machinery.
- The full operation of EWP's.
- Emergency descent system.
- All emergency procedures.
- A theoretical test and a practical observation and demonstration.

5. COURSE OUTCOME.

Once you have successfully passed the Elevating Work Platform Of Australia's EWP training course in Sydney, you'll receive official accreditation and you can do work that involves the use of those types of elevating work platform (EWP) equipment.

6. CANCELLATION.

If fee is prepaid, a minimum notice of 48 hours is required when cancelling a Yellowcard training course assessment. Cancellations within 48 hours of a Yellowcard training course will require the applicant to pay \$350.00 for another training session.

No refund is given for non-attendance or cancellation on day of training.
