COURSE NAME:

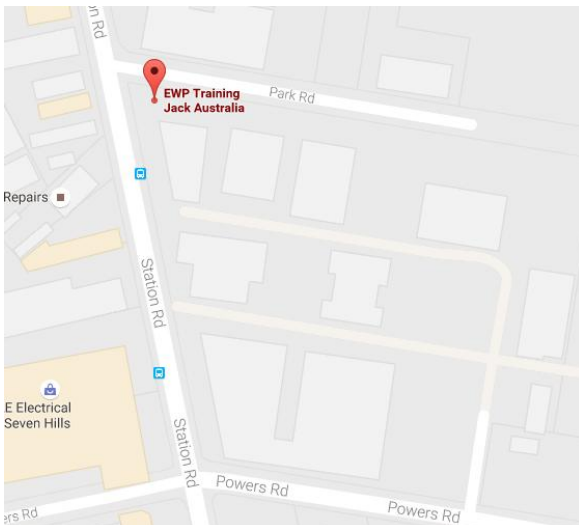
TLILIC2005A - Licence to operate a boom-type elevating work platform (boom length 11 metres or more)

DURATION:

Total duration is 3 days. Training is over two full days and Safework NSW assessment is conducted on the third day.

COURSE COST:

The course fee is \$690.00 per person (GST exempt). This fee includes the Safework NSW assessment fee and all course materials, and one (1) Safework NSW assessment. An additional fee of \$250 will be charged if any extra Safework NSW assessment is required. Please contact us for group training rates.

AGE REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must be over 18 years of age.

PREREQUISITES:

None.

SESSION TIMES:

Training takes place either Monday/Tuesday or Thursday Friday at 7.30am start time.

Bookings essential.

LOCATION:

On site training can be provided, if:

- Suitable training room including tables, chairs and whiteboard.
- Elevating work Platform with a platform height greater than 11 metres in serviceable condition(no faults and up to date service history)
- Safe area to operate machinery.
- Travel and parking costs may apply to onsite training.
- MIN five (5) applicants

***Licence Fee**

A Safework NSW Licence Application Fee of \$67 applies when lodged through Australia Post. You will also be required to supply a passport sized photo for your licence.

1. Course Introduction.

This EWP training course covers all the requirements for obtaining a national High Risk Work Licence (Class WP) for boom-type elevating work platforms.

Successfully completing this course will allow you to operate any boom-type elevating work platform, including self-propelled, trailer mounted and truck mounted boom lifts with a height or reach of 11m or more within Australia.

This course does not cover the requirements for operating vertical lift types or scissor lift type EWPs. A Yellow Card Trained Operator Licence will be required for these types of EWP.

2. Course Outline.

Day 1 – Presentation, Pre start safety checks discussion and EWP operational activities

Day 2 – Practical training, theory review, and unit of competence assessment

Day 3 – Assessment conducted by a Safework NSW accredited assessor.

All participants will gain practical and theoretical knowledge/skills in the following:

- Duty of care and relevant OH&S rules.
- Identification of hazards and assessment of risks and controls.
- Fitting and using the fall harness and how to inspect it.
- Identification of safe operating boundaries by using manual and data plate information.
- Proper procedures for the set-up, use and shut down of all EWP machinery.
- The full operation of EWP.
- Emergency descent system.
- All emergency procedures.
- A theoretical test and a practical observation and demonstration.
- Introduction EWP training aid video, verbal discussion of previous experience.
- Pre start safety checks, and correct use of the EWP yellow log book.
- Practical demonstration on relevant serviced EWP machinery.
- Hazard management, planning and preparing work for EWP.
- OHS regulations and duty of care for the safe use of Elevating work platforms.
- Correct procedures for setting up, operating and shutting down EWP machines.

3. Course Outcome.

Upon successful completion of the elevating work platform training course and successfully completing a Safework NSW assessment, a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment is issued TLILIC2005A - Licence to Operate a Boom-Type Elevating Work Platform (boom length 11 metres or more) and upon lodging the application with workcover (through Australia Post*) a High Risk Work Licence (class WP) will be issued by Safework NSW.

Participants will have gained the following skills and knowledge to:

Plan Work: Hazard management and consultation.

Conduct Routine Checks: Inspect, check service log book, compliance.

Set Up Elevating Work Platform: Ground stability, drive ewp, position ewp.

Operate EWP: Manoeuvring EWP and following site specific procedures.

Shutdown and Secure EWP: Parking, securing and manoeuvring EWP and following site specific procedures.

4. Safework NSW conditions for assessment:

- Applicants to be at least 18 years of age
- Able to produce 100 points or more of identification as per the SafeWork NSW identification checklist.
- Speak and understand English at a level to be able to participate in the training and assessment.

Note: Verbal assessments can be arranged for applicants with writing and reading difficulties. (an extra charge applies)

5. Cancellation.

If fee is prepaid, a minimum notice of 48 hours is required when cancelling a Safework assessment. Cancellations within 48 hours of a Safework assessment will require the applicant to pay \$250.00 for another assessment.

No refund is given for non-attendance or cancellation on day of training.
